# PUBLIC HEARING OF PROPOSED ALLOCATION OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the City of Carson has prepared the Community Development Block Grant Program Year 2024 draft Annual Action Plan. The posting of this notice establishes the beginning of the minimum 30-day public review period required under Federal Regulation 24 CFR 91.105(b)(2). This public review is part of the City of Carson's Citizen Participation Plan, which is intended to facilitate public comment on the 2024 Annual Action Plan document. The draft 2024-2025 Annual Action Plan proposes to allocate \$717,241 of new CDBG funds to eligible projects and activities. A copy of the one-year budget portion of the draft Annual Action Plan is attached for your review. The public review and written comment period begin Thursday May 16, 2024, and runs through June 18, 2024.

The Annual Action Plan is a yearly program document detailing community development priority and the immediate plans of the city to address those priorities. The City of Carson is required to submit an Annual Action Plan to the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to participate in the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program.
