JOINT WORKSHOP (Item 1)

JOINT WORKSHOP: CONSIDER PRELIMINARY IMPROVEMENT PLANS FOR THE CARSON STREET CORRIDOR AND THREE DESIGN ALTERNATIVES

Planning Officer Repp-Loadsman summarized the staff report and recommendation.

Senior Planner Naaseh narrated a PowerPoint presentation and discussed the following:

RECOMMENDATION for the City Council/Redevelopment Agency, Planning Commission, Public Works Commission, and Economic Development Commission:

TAKE THE FOLLOWING ACTIONS:

- 1. CONDUCT the joint workshop.
- 2. VOTE for preferred design alternatives recommended by Gruen Associates.
- 3. PROVIDE additional input on the proposed improvements for Carson Street including, but not limited to, scheduling and identification of funding for construction of the improvements.

ACTION: During the informal session, representatives from Gruen and Associates narrated a PowerPoint presentation and discussed the following:

Traffic Engineer Garland discussed the following:

- Medians
- Accessibility to property

During a question-and-answer period, the following items were discussed: 1) to include native plants and 2) to create a fluid look for the monument signs.

At 7:37 P.M., those present voted on their preferences and at 8:02 P.M., Planning Officer Repp-Loadsman announced the voting results as follows:

- Design Alternative Nos. 1 and 2 received tie votes
- Design Alternative No. 3 was out

General comments were expressed from those who voted for and against Design Alternative Nos. 1 and 2.

Representatives from Gruen Associates discussed design concepts for freeway crossings.

Mayor/Chairman Dear discussed visibility for the Sculpture Garden.

Senior Planner Naaseh summarized why this project was started and reported that the next steps were to take the design alternatives to the community and businesses for a multi-faceted approach to improve Carson Street and share the preferred plans and present the information to the City Council.
