SUBJECT: CONSIDER AN AWARD OF A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR PROJECT NO. 954: MEDIAN IRRIGATION SYSTEM AND LANDSCAPING UPGRADE PHASE II, DEL AMO BOULEVARD FROM AVALON BOULEVARD TO

WILMINGTON AVENUE

I. SUMMARY

Project No. 954: Median Irrigation System and Landscaping Upgrade Phase II, Del Amo Boulevard from Avalon Boulevard to Wilmington Avenue (Exhibit No. 1) plans, specifications and estimates (PS&E) were approved by the City Council on September 6, 2011; staff was authorized to advertise the work and call for bids (Exhibit No. 2). On October 19, 2011, 13 bids were received and opened by the City Clerk. The lowest responsible bidder is PIMA Corporation dba Advanced Construction, with a bid in the amount of \$976,851.00.

This project is subject to the requirement of the city's master Project Labor Agreement (PLA). The selected contractor and all subcontractors have an obligation to comply with all of the terms of the PLA.

II. RECOMMENDATION

TAKE the following actions:

- 1. AWARD a Construction Contract for Project No. 954: Median Irrigation System and Landscaping Upgrade Phase II, Del Amo Boulevard from Avalon Boulevard to Wilmington Avenue, in the amount of \$976,851.00, to the lowest responsible bidder, PIMA Corporation dba Advanced Construction.
- 2. AUTHORIZE the expenditure of a construction contingency, if necessary, in the amount of \$146,527.00 (15%) for change orders such as the removal and remediation of contaminated soil, substructure conflicts, and other unforeseen construction work that may be required to complete this project.
- 3. AUTHORIZE the transfer of \$882,528.00 from the FY 2011/12 Adopted Measure "R" fund budget of \$1,080,000.00 for Project No. 1322: Avalon Boulevard Median Irrigation Upgrades to Project No. 954: Median Irrigation System and Landscaping Upgrade Phase II, Del Amo Boulevard from Avalon Boulevard to Wilmington Avenue.

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4. AUTHORIZE the Mayor to execute the construction contract following approval as to form by the City Attorney.

III. ALTERNATIVES

- 1. REJECT all bids.
- 2. TAKE another action the City Council deems appropriate.

IV. BACKGROUND

The city's Capital Improvement Program calls for the construction of the median irrigation system and landscaping upgrade phase II, Del Amo Boulevard from Avalon Boulevard to Wilmington Avenue under Project No. 954. The project consists of rehabilitating the existing landscape irrigation system and developing a reclaimed water irrigation system. These approximately 8,500 lineal feet of existing landscape medians required the re-evaluation of the irrigation system and landscaping plants, and the replacement of any deficiencies in either element to enhance the performance and aesthetic of the improvement. The proposed improvements will correct over-watering and decrease maintenance costs through the utilization of drought-resistant plants and solar powered controller devices.

On June 1, 2010, the City Council awarded a Professional Services Agreement to MIG, Inc. for the preparation of construction PS&E for Project No. 954: Median Irrigation System and Landscaping Upgrade Phase II, Del Amo Boulevard from Avalon Boulevard to Wilmington Avenue for a negotiated fee not-to-exceed \$79,775.00 (Exhibit No. 3).

On May 9, 2011, the City Council accepted a West Basin Municipal Water District (District) grant in the amount of \$15,000.00 (Exhibit No. 4).

The District maximum grant amount of \$15,000.00 was awarded to offset a portion of the cost of the design for Project No. 954: Median Irrigation System and Landscaping Upgrade Phase II, Del Amo Boulevard from Avalon Boulevard to Wilmington Avenue. According to the grant agreement, "If City does not use these funds for its retrofit project within one year of receipt; City must reimburse the District, the funding originally provided by District, with any interest that has accrued on the funds in the account." Upon project completion, final photos of the project must be submitted. In addition, water usage for up to one year after the project's completion may be requested by the District to monitor water savings for reporting purposes.

On September 6, 2011, the City Council approved the PS&E, and authorized staff to advertise the work and call for bids for Project No. 954: Median Irrigation System and Landscaping Upgrade Phase II, Del Amo Boulevard from Avalon Boulevard to Wilmington Avenue. On September 15, 2011, the project was advertised for construction bids.

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On October 19, 2011, 13 bids were received and opened by the City Clerk as listed below:

Staff has reviewed the bids and finds that the lowest responsible bidder, PIMA Corporation dba Advanced Construction is a bona fide contractor licensed by the state of California. The bid bond, in the amount of 10% of the total bid, as supplied by First National Insurance Company of America, under the laws of the state of Washington is in order and was submitted with the bid. The contractor's references have been checked, and it has been verified that the contractor has completed similar projects in an acceptable manner.

The contractor is a member of the Construction Labor Union of Southern California; therefore, the contractor automatically is in compliance with the PLA regulations.

V. FISCAL IMPACT

Funds in the amount of \$300,000.00 were included in the FY 2010/11 Adopted Measure "R" fund budget for the Del Amo Boulevard median irrigation system and landscaping upgrade, with the unspent balance of \$225,850.00 being rebudgeted in FY 2011/12. The FY 2011/12 Adopted Measure "R" fund budget also included \$1,380,000.00 for future Avalon Boulevard median irrigation system upgrade projects.

The preliminary engineering estimate revealed that the construction cost of this project would be more than initially budgeted. The additional funding requirements information was included in the PS&E agenda report for this project, and the request for additional funds was deferred until the bids were received and the construction contract was to be awarded.

As anticipated, the project construction cost exceeds the \$225,850.00 budget. Therefore, the budget will need to be increased by \$882,528.00. Funds should be transferred from the budgeted \$1,080,000.00 Measure "R" fund for Project No. 1322: Avalon Boulevard Median Irrigation System Upgrades.




