SUBJECT: CONSIDER AUTHORIZATION TO INCREASE THE CONTRACT AMOUNT OF THE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE CARSON REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY AND PIMA CORPORATION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF REFLECTIONS MINI-PARK LOCATED AT 21208 SHEARER

I. <u>SUMMARY</u>

The Carson Redevelopment Agency (Agency) is being asked to authorize an increase of \$35,000.00 to the contract amount of the construction agreement with PIMA Corporation (Contractor). Due to unforeseen design changes required by regulatory agencies during construction, the contract amount for construction has increased. The additional \$35,000.00 will increase Contractor's contract amount to a not-to-exceed amount of \$654,500.00.

II. <u>RECOMMENDATION</u>

AUTHORIZE a \$35,000.00 increase in PIMA Corporation's contract amount to a not-to-exceed amount of \$654,500.00.

III. <u>ALTERNATIVES</u>

TAKE another action the Agency Board deems appropriate.

IV. <u>BACKGROUND</u>

Construction of Reflections Mini-Park (Exhibit No.1) began in June 2011. On July 19, 2011, (Exhibit No. 2) the Agency authorized an increase of \$50,000.00 in the not-to-exceed contract amount, to cover change orders, bringing the contract amount to \$619,500.00. Due to other changes required during construction, staff is requesting an additional increase of \$35,000.00 to the contract amount. This increase will bring the total contract amount to \$654,500.00. This revised contract amount represents a total increase of 15% above the original contract amount.

An example of a significant change to construction is as follows: subsequent to the county reviewing plans and permitting the construction of a block wall over a county storm drain, the county reversed its approach and a portion of the wall had to be redesigned, resulting in that portion being replaced by a metal fence which caused an increase in the budgeted amount for that line item.

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Staff, therefore, now requests that the contract amount be increased by \$35,000.00 in anticipation of additional costs. The total contract increase is still well under the allowable 25%.

V. FISCAL IMPACT

Funds for this amendment are included in the proposed FY 2011/12 Redevelopment Agency budget.


