I. <u>SUMMARY</u>

On June 6, 2012, the City Council voted to waive feees for the use of the Congresswoman Juanita Millender-McDonald Community Center at Carson (Community Center) for three community groups that previously received funding by the City Council through the City's Cultural Arts Commission (Exhibit No.1). The fee waiver was provided in order to assist these groups with holding rehearsals, meetings, and their fundraising efforts. The term of the fee waiver was for all of Fiscal Year 2012/13. Tonight, the City Council is asked to provide direction to staff regarding whether to continue waiving the fees for the use of the Community Center for these three groups for Fiscal Year 2013/14.

II. RECOMMENDATION

DISCUSS and PROVIDE direction to staff.

III. <u>ALTERNATIVES</u>

TAKE another action the City Council deems appropriate.

IV. <u>BACKGROUND</u>

The City of Carson has provided funding for fine arts programming through the Cultural Arts Commission since the 1980s. With the City's budget challenges, this program was suspended until a time when it would be financially feasible for the City to restart the program. In the interim, on June 6, 2012 the City Council voted to waive fees for use of the Community Center for three groups that had received funding in prior years: Asociacion Cultural de South Bay of Greater Los Angeles Mariachi Academy (Mariachi Academy of Carson). Apollo West Carson Players, and Sophisticated Dance. This action was taken in order to assist these groups with their fundraising activities, as well as to hold meetings and rehearsals.

Tonight, the City Council is asked to provide direction to staff regarding whether to extend this fee waiver for all of Fiscal Year 2013/14.
