I. <u>SUMMARY</u>

IV. <u>BACKGROUND</u>

The Leaves of Carson is an awards program that the Public Relations Commission started in 2003 to recognize individuals or organizations for their outstanding volunteer efforts in the Carson Community.

Five awardees are selected in five different categories, namely Public Safety, Non-Profit, Education, Business, and Public Sector. A sixth, posthumous category may be added at the discretion of the City Council.

The Leaves of Carson honorees will be recognized in a Ceremonial Presentation in October that will take place in the City Hall Council Chambers. The honorees' names will be engraved on a leaf and added to the "tree of life", which is displayed at the Community Center.
