






### **I. SUMMARY**

This item is on the agenda at the request of Mayor *Pro Tem* Santarina.

On November 19, 2013, the City Council approved to waive fees for the use of the Congresswoman Juanita Millender-McDonald Community Center at Carson for both a community vigil and community concert to raise funds. Two weekend drive thru/drop off donation collections have taken place at City Hall.

Tonight, the City Council is asked to hear an oral report from the City Treasurer reporting the most up-to-date dollar amount for donations received as of the close of business Tuesday, December 3, 2013. The City Council is also asked to determine which organization the funds will be donated to. The Mayor *Pro Tem* recommends that the funds be donated to Alto Broadcasting System - Chronicle Broadcasting Network (ABS-CBN).

2. APPROVE the donation of all items and monies collected to Alto Broadcasting System - Chronicle Broadcasting Network.

### **IV. BACKGROUND**

On November 14, 2013, an organizing meeting was held by the Mayor *Pro Tem* to discuss ways for the community to come together to raise funds and collect donated items to be sent to the Philippines to aid the victims of Typhoon Haiyan which devastated the Philippine Islands on November 8, 2013.

Typhoon Haiyan was the strongest storm to touch ground in its history. The Typhoon devastated the island of Leyte affecting 11 million people. It is estimated that nearly 1 million are homeless and thousands have lost their lives. Aid from throughout the world and our nation is making its way to help the victims. Mayor *Pro Tem* Santarina has been leading the efforts to raise funds and collect donated items to aid the survivors of the Typhoon Haiyan.

The City is having another fundraising event on Sunday, December 15, 2013, from 2:00 p.m. -6:00 p.m. The City of Carson will be producing its first telethon in which viewers can call in and donate. All proceeds will be donated toward relief efforts.

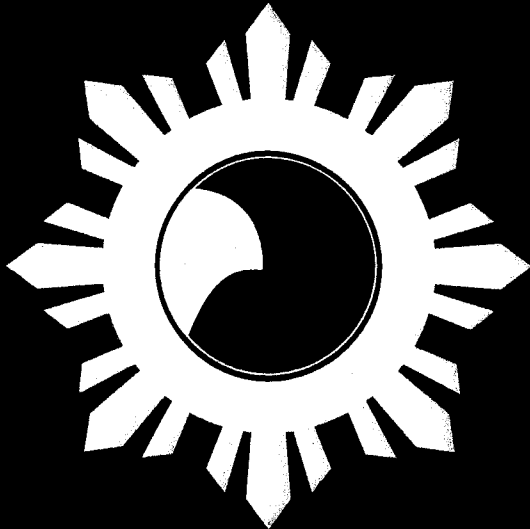
