#### I. <u>SUMMARY</u>

This item is on the agenda at the request of Councilmember Davis-Holmes, as approved by the City Council.

Councilwoman Davis-Holmes requests the Council discuss eliminating the socalled two-step process which relates to the manner in which members of the City Council add items to future agendas.

#### II. <u>RECOMMENDATION</u>

CONSIDER and PROVIDE direction.

#### III. ALTERNATIVES

- 1. DIRECT Staff to draft amendments to the Carson Municipal Code relating to the way in which Councilmembers add items to the agenda so as to ELIMINATE the two-step process.
- 2. DO NOT ELIMINATE the two-step process.
- 3. REFER to the City Council Policy Committee for further discussion.

#### IV. BACKGROUND

On April 2, 2013, the so called two-step process was reinstated by the City Council. Proponents of the two-step process have been of the opinion that this process makes for a more orderly creation and assembly of the agenda.

Councilwoman Daivs-Holmes wishes to go back to the process simply requiring Councilmembers to give advance notice of their intent to add items to a future agenda to the City Manager without obtaining permission from a majority of the City Council.

### V. FISCAL IMPACT

If the City Council wishes to eliminate the two-step process such time to prepare staff reports may not be any greater than that currently expended under the existing two-step process. Accordingly, it is not possible to estimate the fiscal impact, if any, from actions considered in this staff report.
