

Summer 2020 – City of Carson Pool Rules (Subject to change)

- Masks are required for entry and must be worn at all times (except in the water)
- Temperature checks are taken prior to entry
- Pool use by reservation only for City of Carson, CA residents
- Proof of residency required
- Reserved section can only be occupied by those living in the same household
- A Waiver Form must be completed and submitted prior to entry
- Children under 7 years of age must be accompanied by an adult (18 years and above) and must remain within an arm's reach at all times
- Proper Swim Attire Required:
 - Female:
 - One- or two-piece bathing suit
 - Swim shorts (optional)
 - Plain/No Logo White T-Shirt (optional)
 - Male:
 - Swim Shorts, Board Shorts, Jammers, or Speedos
 - Plain/No Logo White T-Shirt (optional)
 - Note: Those who do not have the proper swim attire will be asked to exit the pool.
- After entry, users will be asked to report to their Section and stay in their own section
- Personal belongings will be assigned an area to use on deck by your designated section
- Upon exiting the pool, quickly replace your mask
- Exit at the designated area immediately and not through the front
- Showers are not available at this time.
- Restroom use is available upon request and you will be assigned a number to use.
- Play items allowed in the pool:
 - Up to 5 Small toys
 - Up to 2 Small soft balls
 - Up to 8 Noodles
 - Small floatation device that will not block the lifeguards view of the pool bottom

*Note: Make sure all items remain in your designated section at all times. Any misuse of the above-mentioned items is subject to removal of the item.
- Jumping into the pool is okay, but sitting on the pool edge for more than 5 minutes is not.
- All users on the pool deck must be in the water. Those who are not swimming will need to wait outside.
- Approved lifesaving floatation devices (both Coast Guard approved):



- Those who repeatedly exhibit unsafe behavior(s) and/or refuse to comply with any of the above-mentioned rules will be asked to exit the facility.
