Project Description

The Carson Street Master Plan Implementation Project is providing 1.75 miles of new and

enhanced streetscape and infrastructure for the Carson Street Corridor between the I-110 and I-405 freeways. Improvements include installation of a recycled water line, extensive colorful, drought-tolerant landscaping in parkways and medians, street furniture (benches, bike racks, and pedestrian lights), public art, entry monuments, traffic signal modifications, reconfiguration of turn lanes, reconstruction of driveways for ADA



compliance, and replacement of median street lights with LED lights.

The entrance to City Hall at Carson and Avalon is also being refurbished including the construction of an ADA compliant ramp along with hardscape and landscape improvements.

Project Status


Preliminary Items: Traffic control plans have been reviewed and approved by the City Traffic Engineer, providing one travel lane in each direction on Carson Street between Avalon Blvd and Dolores St. The change to one travel lane was necessitated by the increased depth of the recycled water line, which required expansion of the construction work zone. The implementation of proposed widening of the sidewalk and parkway areas on both sides of the street also require a reduction of traffic to one lane. Sidewalks will only be closed on one side of Carson St. at a time to reduce the impact on pedestrian traffic. Temporary striping and delineators have been deployed to maintain safe traffic flow through construction zones.

Recycled Water (RW) Line Installation: Final profile design of the recycled water line between the new limits of Main St. to Bonita St. has been approved by West Basin Municipal Water District. Recycled water line installation has been completed between Dolores St. and Grace Ave.





Revised RW Line Installation Limits:



City Hall Improvements: Reconnection of existing utility lines around the City Hall entrance is ongoing. The upper level under-slab has been graded and poured. Construction of the stairs of installation of the architectural pavers will take place in the coming weeks.

Streetscape Improvements: Construction of new driveways and curb/gutter is continuing along the south side of Carson Street. Median curb removal and replacement between Orrick Ave. and Figueroa St. (City-added scope) has also commenced. Trenching and installation of irrigation lines and electrical conduit on the south side are also proceeding per plan.



Executed Change Order

Contract Change Order #1, in the amount of \$963,438.14 (5.7 % of the original contract amount) is currently being processed for signatures. This change order includes changes in scope and unforeseen conditions encountered during City Hall improvements, repair of existing median street lights, additional removals/reconstruction of median curbs, and a portion of the scope changes related to the recycled water line installation.

Classification and disposal of hazardous subgrade material within Carson St.



Project Schedule Update

Due to changes in the scope of work related to the recycled water line profile and added scope for removal and replacement of damaged/deteriorating median curbs, the project schedule has deviated significantly from the baseline CPM schedule submitted at the beginning of the project. A revisited CPM schedule has been submitted by the Contractor and currently under City review.



Project Look-Ahead

Recycled water line installation is scheduled to continue between Grace Ave. and Avalon Blvd. through the end of February. The Contractor will then move recycled water line operations to between Dolores St. and Main St. for the month of March. Streetscape improvements in the medians and the south side of Carson St. are expected to continue through July.

Due to lost days as a result of inclement weather and unforeseen complications with existing utility lines, substantial completion of City Hall improvements is now expected for the end of March.
