- 1890 – Rapheal Poggi
- 1893 – Christopher Fiesel – Purchased land and farmed – 10 children
- 1911 – Jared Sidney Torrance – “City Strip” purchase
- 1920 – Charles Jentsch – Purchased land – Chickens/Farm – “Nestoria”  
(Father of Gertrude Schwartz) – East 220th
