City of Carson Release SB1 Local Street and Road Improvement Project List

Local Projects Will Improve Safety, Extend Road Life

The City of Carson has released a list of (Pavement Rehabilitation Program which includes (4,044,123 sq. ft.) of arterials, secondary arterials and collector roads improvement projects within the next 10 years designed to make it easier and safer to travel in the region. The project list was developed as part of the requirements of Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017, which is also providing much of the funding to do the work.

The list includes the following five projects:

- \$1.6 million Del Amo Boulevard -Phase I- Rehabilitation from Avalon Blvd. to Central Ave.
- \$ 1.6 million Del Amo Boulevard -Phase II- Rehabilitation from Central Ave. to Wilmington Ave.
- \$ 1.6 million Turmount Street Rehabilitation from Avalon Blvd. to Central Ave.
- \$1.6 million Main Street -Phase I- Rehabilitation from Sepulveda Blvd. to 228th Street.
- \$1.6 million Main Street -Phase II- Rehabilitation from 228th Street to Carson Street.

There is also a state component to the new transportation funding. Caltrans also released a list of projects it will be pursuing on the state roads and highways that connect South Bay Cities with the rest of the state. The list includes:

- I-110 Travel Time Displays
- \$1.9 million traffic management systems project will install 76 wireless Bluetooth detection systems to monitor travel time on Interstate 110 -within the City of Long Beach- from Gaffey Street to I-405.

Taken together, these projects will make significant improvements in the transportation infrastructure, mobility options, create jobs and help grow the local economy.
