SOUTHBOUND ON-RAMP OPENING

The City of Carson and Caltrans continue efforts to improve the interchange at Avalon Boulevard and Interstate 405. The new on-ramp to southbound Interstate 405 opened to the public on December 1, 2011.

Work is continuing in the loop ramp area of the interchange, with additional paving taking place this month. This stage construction work is expected to be completed by the end of January 2012 and motorists can expect another traffic control change at that time. Work on the Lenardo Bridge, across the Torrance Lateral Channel, will continue with placement of precast, concrete girders placed later this month. The reconstruction of the northbound ramps continues. Replacement of the bridge rail across the Dominquez Channel Bridge on Avalon Boulevard continues also.

Those traveling through the area are reminded to “slow for the cone zone” as workers will continue these activities adjacent to traffic.

About This Project

Construction of this \$19,000,000 project, Avalon Boulevard interchange modification at the I-405 freeway, in the City of Carson, started in August 2010. The project is realigning and improving existing ramps, adding a new southbound I-405 on-ramp, widening 213th Street Bridge, constructing a new bridge to access The Boulevards project, building eight retaining walls and a sound wall, construction of Lenardo Drive, and widening Avalon Boulevard. The entire project is expected to be completed by May, 2012.
