I. <u>Introduction</u>

Due to cost factors and market conditions, the applicant, Timothy Higdon, on behalf of Kinder Morgan Energy Partners, L.P., is proposing a modification from the original approval in order to delay the construction of 15 petroleum storage tanks and the removal of one older petroleum storage tank. The proposed project is located on the southwestern 27.5 acres of the entire 99-acre tank farm facility. The subject property is zoned MH (Manufacturing, Heavy) and located at **2000 E. Sepulveda Boulevard.**

II. Discussion

Due to a discrepancy in the noticing of the public hearing and intent to adopt a negative declaration with the County Clerk, staff is requesting that the Planning Commission continue this item to February 24, 2009.

III. Recommendation
