#### I. Introduction

This item was originally scheduled for the June 12, 2012 Planning Commission hearing. On June 11, 2012, staff received a letter from the applicant's attorney contesting a number of the conditions of approval that were added by staff. These conditions were written to protect the future occupants/owners of the added units since these units are within close proximity to the capped oil wells. In addition, the applicant's attorney indicated that the city has no jurisdiction regarding adding conditions of approval regarding oil wells since the conditions concern infrastructure, condition and maintenance of the park's facilities. The attorney requested that Condition Nos. 69, 70, and 71 be removed.

#### II. Background

Staff has contacted California Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) regarding the attorney's comments. HCD regulates many aspects of mobile home parks. However, HCD has indicated that the city has authority to add conditions of approval in regards to oil wells. Therefore, staff has requested Department of Conservation Division of Oil, Gas and Geothermal (DOGGR) to issue their comment letter/conditions of approval. Staff has not received DOGGR's response and is requesting a continuance to the July 10<sup>th</sup> Planning Commission hearing.
