SPECIAL UPDATE ON PROTESTS ENSUED BY THE DEATH OF GEORGE FLOYD

• **Protests and Marches Sparked By The Death of George Floyd** while in police custody began last week throughout the country and continued through the weekend. While there were peaceful organized marches in protest, unruly individuals managed to cause destruction of many business and private property throughout L.A. County. We are happy to report that with the assistance of our extra vigilant Carson residents who immediately reported suspicious activity at South bay Pavilion to the Carson Sheriff Station, arrest were made immediately.

"While you were sleeping your Carson Station personnel made multiple arrests to protect local businesses from those that attempted looting.
