- A Record Number of COVID-19 Cases Were Reported on Wednesday, June 17 by the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health with 34 new deaths and 2,129 new cases.

- Approximately 50% of the 2,000 Restaurants Visited by Inspectors Were Not in Compliance with Health Guidelines according to L.A. County Public Health Director Dr. Barbara Ferrer.
- A Modified Health Officer Order and Directives Allowing for Additional Business Sectors to Reopen Effective Friday, June 19 was issued on Thursday, June 18.
