Many local jurisdictions have passed laws that offer temporary relief and/or protections from eviction for reasons related to the COVID-19 emergency.

>> You can access our local jurisdiction law tracker at: bit.ly/3aAxMF9

>> Each city has its own order, consult your city's order prior to issuing an eviction notice or responding to an eviction notice or complaint.

>>Note on definitions:

Affirmative Defense - Landlord/manager can file for eviction BUT you can make a case in court / defend yourself if reason for eviction/breach of lease was caused by COVID19

Moratorium - Landlord manager cannot file for eviction

> **For non- payment of rent due to COVID19** → you will need to write to your landlord and demonstrate proof

> **For no-fault evictions** - evictions where the tenant is not at fault (i.e landlord wants to move immediate family in, landlord wants to remove unit from market)

Rent Freeze - Rents temporarily suspended.



The Los Angeles County Superior Courts are closed and tenants are not required to respond to eviction (unlawful detainer) complaints until April 17, 2020.

>>The Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department is currently not conducting lockouts of tenants based on court judgements, even if the case was lost prior to the pandemic.



It is unlawful to discriminate on the basis of race, national origin, and ethnicity.

>>Furthermore, social stigma undermines social cohesion & prompts possible social isolation of groups which might negatively contribute to the spread of the virus.

>>CORONAVIRUS doesn't recognize race, nationality, or ethnicity.

Apartment and House Hunter's Checklist

Before you start looking for a place, get organized and decide: 1) how much you can afford to pay, 2) what your space and living needs are, 3) how long you plan on staying, and 4) what sort of area you want to live in.

When you find a potential unit be sure that the answers to these questions are covered in or added to your rental agreement. And don't leave without a copy of any amendments—it's worth a detour to the local copy center.

1. When is the unit available? If the move-in date is impractical for you, ask if it's negotiable so that you don't pay for unoccupied time. Is the apartment currently occupied? Is the lease agreement month-to-month or year-to-year?
2. How much are rent and deposit fees, and when is rent due? If mailed, does the rent need to be received or postmarked by the due date?
3. Is there a grace period after the monthly rental due date? When is your payment considered late, and is there a penalty charge for late payment?
4. What are the terms for renewing the lease? Can you move into an apartment you like better if one becomes vacant? What are the conditions if you have to move before the lease expires?
5. Are pets allowed?
6. Are any utilities included in your agreement?
7. Are you allowed to have roommates? What is the policy on subletting?
8. Can you paint the walls or make other decorating changes?
9. Will you be responsible for any property maintenance? Is there an office onsite, or a 24-hour phone number in case of an emergency?
10. Is the unit a legal dwelling?

Application Screening Fee

A landlord can charge you an application screening fee to cover his/her out-of-pocket expenses for obtaining and processing your application. The application fee cannot be more than the landlord's actual out-of-pocket costs, and effective in 2018, can never be more than \$49.12. The landlord must give you an itemized receipt showing his/her expenses and must return any unused portion of the fee (for example, if the landlord did not check your references).

A Checklist of Things to Inspect

Here is a checklist of things you should look for when inspecting a rental property. All requirements mentioned are contained in the California Civil Code. Please slow down and look carefully before you sign on the dotted line.

Get all Promises in Writing

Whatever promises the landlord makes, you should be aware that it is very common for vague, oral agreements to lead to misunderstanding, bitterness, and financial loss. The time to protect yourself is now. Get all promises in writing. Make two copies, one for the landlord and one for your own file.

The Landlord-Tenant Checklist

Another good self-protection device for both landlords and tenants involves taking an inventory of the condition of the premises at the time you move in, and then again when you move out. This means no more than making a brief written record of the condition of each room and having it signed by you and your landlord. Not only does the inventory give both an accurate record of the condition of the unit, but the act of making it provides a framework for communication and the resolution of potential disputes about security deposits when you move out. Contact the Housing Rights Center to receive a sample checklist. It is also a good idea to take pictures of your unit when you move in and move out.

HOMELESSNESS PREVENTION PROGRAM

What is Homelessness Prevention?

Homelessness Prevention provides individuals and families who are **at imminent risk of homelessness** with:

- Financial assistance and housing stabilization services necessary to maintain their current housing; OR
- Find new housing to avoid becoming homeless and entering the emergency shelter system.

Who is eligible for the Homelessness Prevention Program?

- Homelessness Prevention may be available to persons who are currently residing within Los Angeles County, screened as having a **high risk of becoming homeless** **AND** meet **at least one** of the following criteria:
 - ✓ Experiencing a financial crisis and at imminent risk of becoming homeless within 30 days.
 - ✓ Have received written notice of intent to terminate tenancy from a landlord, property manager or lease holder.
 - ✓ Have received an Unlawful Detainer (court eviction hearing notice or court-ordered eviction).

What are the required Income eligibility guidelines for assistance?

- Must fall below the 50% Area Median Income (AMI)
- Formerly Homeless Section 8 holders with income up to 80% of Area Median Income (AMI)

What are LAHSA Interim Housing programs?

As mentioned, these Interim Housing programs are designed to support people experiencing homelessness to attain permanent housing. Each program provides regular meals, showers, and case management, as well as a bed.

The eligibility and population will often determine whether Crisis or Bridge is the best fit for the participant—access to both are described below.

Winter Shelter :

Operate only from December to March

First-come, first-served shelter bed
Low barrier to entry, meaning basic eligibility standards;
Participant is:
-> Experiencing homelessness
-> Ambulatory, and self-care capable

Crisis Housing :

First-come, first-served shelter bed
Low barrier to entry, meaning basic eligibility standards;
Participant is:
-> Experiencing homelessness
-> Ambulatory, and self-care capable

Bridge Housing :

Admission based on eligibility screening*
Participant is:
-> Experiencing homelessness
-> Ambulatory, and self-care capable
-> State or High-risk (Acuity) of chronic homelessness

- High-acuity (8 or above), or

- Collectively, we serve participants who are:
- Experiencing Homelessness in LA County*
 - Over the age of 18 years old**

* Persons fleeing Domestic/Intimate Partner Violence may also access LAHSA shelter sites, as eligible
** LAHSA has a limited number of funded beds for Unaccompanied Minors (persons between 12-17 years old)

- There are also specialty programs for:
- > Women
 - > Veterans
 - > Older Adults (55+); and,
 - > People Exiting (or have recently exited) Institutions

Considerations for any person(s) seeking shelter:

- Do you have mobility needs?
- Do you need a bottom bunk, or do you have trouble with stairs?
- Are you able to practice self-care, and participate at the site independently?

If the person(s) seeking shelter are experiencing significant cognitive impairment and/or health instability, an Interim Housing program may not be suitable for them!

Frequently Asked Questions

Can I drop someone off?

Did the program tell you there was a bed available?
To be sure that a person is connected to Interim Housing be sure that:
1) A bed is available
2) A program staff person acknowledges you or your person’s arrival
This is what we call a “warm hand-off”.

Are these locations open on weekends?

Yes, these programs all operate daily, serving the people in their program with –at minimum - meals, referrals, and a bed nightly.
Staff are not always available to bring in new people. Please note the intake hours listed on each site; these are the hours when the program is best equipped to receive you / a person experiencing homelessness.

Can young people go into an Adult program?

Yes. Our Interim Housing Adult programs can serve people who are 18 years old and older, and are experiencing homelessness.
We also have Interim Housing for Transition Age Youth (TAY) for people who are 18 years and older, but younger than 25 years old.

How can someone connect to the “Additional Interim Housing” programs?

The “Additional Interim Housing” programs are unique in that they serve specific populations, and have specialized eligibility.

In order to facilitate the review of referrals, and support the placement of those referred, these programs only accept referrals from the Countywide Interim Housing Matcher (InterimHousing@LAHSA.org)

Read on below for definitions of these programs and their eligibility.

Bridge Housing, for People Exiting Institutions (B7) :

Participant is:

- o Exiting or has exited an institution (foster care, jail/prison, other detention center, hospital setting) in the past 60 days*
 - If exited, the participant is *presently* experiencing homelessness
 - If exiting, they *would* experience homelessness upon exit**
- o Ambulatory, and self-care capable

* A participant’s eligibility is frozen at referral; as long as they were eligible when their referral was received

** A participant who is exiting an institution would need a Self-Declaration of Homeless Status at the point of referral

Enhanced Bridge Housing (for Women) :

Participants:

- o Identify as women, and
- o Are shelter eligible:
 - Experiencing homelessness
 - Ambulatory, and self-care capable, and,
- o Are Bridge Housing-eligible:
 - High-acuity (8 or above), or
 - Connected to a housing voucher (e.g. Section 8), and/or,
 - Connected to a Housing Search and Placement program (e.g. Rapid Re-Housing, Housing Navigation)

Enhanced Bridge Housing (for Older Adults) :

Participants:

- o Are 55 years old or older
- o Are shelter eligible (see above)
- o Are Bridge Housing-eligible (see above)

A Bridge Home :

Participants:

- o Are shelter-eligible*, and
- o Are Bridge Housing-eligible (see above)

* Prioritization for persons experiencing homelessness in the “Catchment Area” or community in which the project is based.
Depending on the phase of the project, this may be the only criteria
