

ORDINANCE NO. 10-1457

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CARSON, CALIFORNIA
ESTABLISHING POUND REGULATIONS AND AMENDING
THE CARSON MUNICIPAL CODE

WHEREAS, the city of Carson contracts with the Los Angeles County Department of Animal Care and Control and, as a result of that agreement, seeks to closely align the fees charged for animal licensing services with those charged by the Los Angeles County Department of Animal Care and Control; and

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles County Department of Animal Care and Control has experienced an increase in their costs of providing services and have subsequently increased the fees charged for providing animal licensing services; and

WHEREAS, the city of Carson seeks to obtain cost recovery for the increased cost of services provided by aligning the Fee Schedule contained within the Carson Municipal Code with the fees charged by the Los Angeles County Department of Animal Care and Control.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARSON, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 3310 of the Carson Municipal Code, related to the Fee Schedule for animal licensing, is hereby amended to read:

3310. Fee Schedule.

Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 3300, Chapter 10.90 of Division 3, Title 10 of the Los Angeles County Code is amended by amending Section 10.90.010, Part VI to read:

VI. Individual Animal Licenses.

Every person owning a dog or cat over the age of four (4) months shall obtain an annual license and tag for such dog or cat; except, there shall be a one-time-only fee for registration of discharged military dogs, for guide dogs or Seeing-eye dogs, for signal dogs trained to assist the hearing impaired, for service dogs trained to perform tasks to assist the physically handicapped, and for spayed or neutered dogs belonging to senior citizens upon payment of the following fees:
