

This recognition is given posthumously to a resident for his/her efforts to improve the lives of seniors in the community.

The Commission ultimately voted in favor of recommending Congresswoman Juanita Millender-McDonald to receive this posthumous recognition (Exhibit No. 1). She will be joined by the two previously approved nominees, Nellie "Sissy" Karacozian and Rev. Dr. Maurice I. Lemons, Sr. (Exhibit No. 2). The installation ceremony for the three honorees is scheduled for Monday, August 22, 2011, at 11:00 a.m., in the Carson Dominguez Senior Hall of the Community Center.
