

RESOLUTION NO. 11-102

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARSON,
CALIFORNIA, IN SUPPORT OF CALIFORNIA ASSEMBLY BILL 1226,
CAYLEE'S LAW

WHEREAS, Casey Anthony, mother of Caylee Anthony, failed to report her daughter missing for 31 days and her remains were not discovered until five months later; and

WHEREAS, Casey Anthony was charged, tried and later acquitted of the murder of her daughter, Caylee Anthony; and

WHEREAS, there is no existing Florida law or statute that makes failure of notification to law enforcement of a missing child a crime, as is the current situation in California; and

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 1226, Caylee's Law, will make the failure of a parent, guardian or caregiver to report the death of a child within two hours or report a child missing within 48 hours, a felony.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the city of Carson, California, does hereby resolve as follows:

Section 1. That the City Council of the city of Carson, California, supports the proposed legislation, Assembly Bill 1226, Caylee's Law.

Section 2. That the Mayor shall sign and the City Clerk shall attest to the adoption of this resolution.

Section 3. That staff shall submit said document to California State Assemblymembers Paul Cook, Cathleen Galgiani, Isadore Hall, III, Kevin Jeffries, David Valadao, Warren Furutani, and California State Senators Tom Berryhill and Ted Lieu.
