I. SUMMARY

The 2010 Congestion Management Program (CMP) adopted by the Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) requires local jurisdictions to hold a noticed public hearing (Exhibit No. 1) and adopt a resolution self-certifying their conformance with the CMP Local Development Report (Exhibit No. 2).

II. RECOMMENDATION

TAKE the following actions:

- 1. OPEN the Public Hearing, TAKE public testimony, and CLOSE the Public Hearing.
- 2. WAIVE further reading and ADOPT Resolution No. 11-099, "A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARSON, CALIFORNIA, FINDING THE CITY OF CARSON TO BE IN CONFORMANCE WITH THE CONGESTION MANAGEMENT PROGRAM AND ADOPTING THE CONGESTION MANAGEMENT PROGRAM LOCAL DEVELOPMENT REPORT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CALIFORNIA GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 65089."

III. <u>ALTERNATIVES</u>

DENY the recommendations. However, if the City Council does not adopt the resolution, a portion of the city's annual Gas Tax funds could be at risk and funding that is obtained through the Metro for transportation projects could be jeopardized.

IV. BACKGROUND

The CMP for Los Angeles County, which is administered by the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (LACMTA), is a countywide program that is intended to address the impact of local growth on the regional transportation system.
