I. SUMMARY

On July 19, 2011, the City Council directed staff to bring Resolution No. 11-094 back to the Council on August 2, 2011 and in the meantime have the City Attorney's office independently verify the facts in this resolution. That verification has been done.

On July 5, 2011, the City Council added this matter to the July 19, 2011 City Council agenda for consideration at the request of Councilmember Santarina.

Tonight the City Council is asked to consider Resolution No. 11-094 declaring the city of Carson a "Human Trafficking Free City".

II. RECOMMENDATION

TAKE the following actions:

Harris, (4) U.S. Attorney General Eric H. Holder Jr., and (5) Jerome Horton, Chairman of the CA State Board of Equalization (6) Acting Captain Rivero of the Carson Sheriff's Station.
