#### I. <u>SUMMARY</u>

The Vera Carson Mobilehome Park Resident Association has requested assistance from the city of Carson (City) to support its efforts in preserving affordable housing in the community. Assistance is currently needed in the form of a support letter to be submitted with the application for financing from the state's Mobilehome Park Resident Ownership Program (MPROP).

### II. <u>RECOMMENDATION</u>

TAKE the following actions:

- 1. APPROVE the letter of support of the residents of the Vera Carson Mobilehome Park.
- 2. AUTHORIZE the Mayor to sign the letter of support.

### III. <u>ALTERNATIVES</u>

- 1. MODIFY and APPROVE the letter of support as the City Council deems necessary.
- 2. TAKE another action the City Council deems appropriate.

### IV. <u>BACKGROUND</u>

Residents of the Vera Carson Mobilehome Park, located at 21811 Vera Street, Carson (Exhibit No. 1), seek to form a nonprofit California mutual benefit corporation in order to purchase the Vera Carson Mobilehome Park (Mobilehome Park) from the current owners. Purchasing the Mobilehome Park will give residents the ability to keep rents low. The residents will apply for financing assistance from the state's MPROP to purchase the Mobilehome Park. As part of the application process, the residents must show local support from the City.

A conversion to resident ownership compliments the City's efforts to provide affordable housing for the community, therefore, staff recommends approving the letter of support (Exhibit No. 2).

### **City of Carson**

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Any future consideration for assistance is conditioned upon, among other things, approval of a formal proposal from the Mobilehome Park residents upon resolution of the stay order issued for Redevelopment Agencies by the California Supreme Court.


