




**SUBJECT: SET A PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER RECOMMENDED CHANGES TO THE
UNIFORM COMPREHENSIVE SCHEDULE OF FEES**

I. SUMMARY

The city's Uniform Comprehensive Schedule of Fees was last updated, via the adoption of Resolution No. 10-060, on July 20, 2010. As part of the policy issues that were discussed at the May 31, 2011, budget workshop, staff recommended the review of possible increases in the fees. Moreover, in a memo from the Interim City Manager dated July 14, 2011, staff proposed to further look into several items after the budget was adopted on July 11, 2011. One of the items listed relates to the possible increase in certain fees. Staff has completed the review of the fee structure and requests the City Council to set a public hearing to consider the recommended changes to the current schedule of fees.

II. RECOMMENDATION

SET the matter for public hearing on October 4, 2011.

III. ALTERNATIVES

SELECT an alternate date for the public hearing.

IV. BACKGROUND

The City Council adopted Resolution No. 10-060 on July 20, 2010. This resolution serves as the master schedule of fees that are charged by the city for materials and services provided to the public.

During the May 31, 2011, budget workshop held to review the proposed general fund budget for FY 2011/12, staff presented policy issues for discussion which included possible increases in fees. After City Council adopted the budget on July 11, 2011, the Interim City Manager sent a memorandum to the Mayor and Councilmembers regarding the final changes to the FY 2011/12 General Fund Budget (Exhibit No. 3). In that memo, staff once again proposed to further look into the possible increases in certain fees.

The Administrative Services work group requested the assistance of other work groups in reviewing and, if warranted, adjusting the fees being charged for their materials or services. In the course of the review, every effort has been exercised by staff to ascertain that the city is recouping the full cost of providing the materials and services.

The proposed changes to the current fee structure are incorporated in Resolution No. 11-086 attached as Exhibit No. 1. To highlight the specific areas that were being proposed for modification, the red-lined version of Resolution No. 10-060 is likewise attached (Exhibit No. 2). The most notable changes shown in these documents include: (1) fee increases for the community center room rental at the rate of 10%, (2) imposition of a new communications deposit of \$2,500.00 plus any additional cost, (3) a reduction of street vacation fees from \$2,500.00 to \$1,200.00, to more closely reflect the actual cost of manhours, (4) increases to the early childhood program fees, (5) adjustments to certain programs of the Parks and Recreation Division, and (6) increases in the youth services program fees.

Staff is requesting that the City Council set the public hearing for October 4, 2011, to provide the general public and the citizens of Carson an opportunity to express their views on the proposed changes.

V. FISCAL IMPACT

None at this time.

SUBJECT: FINAL CHANGES TO THE FY 2011/12 GENERAL FUND BUDGET

DATE: JULY 14, 2011

At the budget workshop on Monday, July 11, 2011, the City Council adopted the FY 2011/12 general fund budget, as amended. Those amendments included two groups of items – 1) a list of minor corrections and adjustments that were detailed for the City Council on Exhibit 1 which was attached to the July 11, 2011, staff report, and 2) changes proposed by staff or Council during the budget workshop that evening.

The changes made that night at the meeting are detailed below for your reference:

Increase the part-time budget in Adult Sports to reflect the correct amount needed to operate the program	\$19,233
Increase the part-time budget in Transportation – Admin to cover non-Prop A & C trips	\$1,000
Increase the part-time budget in Transportation – Operations to cover non-Prop A & C trips	\$3,000
Add an allocation for overtime to the City Clerk's budget	\$5,000
Add an allocation for overtime to the City Treasurer's budget	\$2,500
Approve funding for one vacant, unfunded Council Field Rep position	\$95,000

The final budget numbers and the corresponding resolution are currently being finalized. Once that is complete, the resolution will be sent to the Mayor for signature. The budget will then be posted on the City's website and copies will be produced and distributed to the Mayor, City Council, City Clerk, City Treasurer and staff.

Additionally, two budget referrals need to be completed – overtime and professional services. As soon as those are complete, they will be forwarded to the Council.

Lastly, there were several items that staff had proposed to look into further after the budget was adopted and those include: 1) the possible consolidation of parks & recreation and human services; 2) the evaluation of services that no longer have significant enrollment/participation; 3) consideration of filling future full-time vacancies with part-time staff or contracting out; 4) examining alternative ways to finance capital equipment replacement and capital improvement projects; 5) a policy to allow a portion of divisional savings to go back to the division; 6) developing a capital equipment

replacement program for the Community Center; 7) the possible increase in certain fees; 8) the deferral of certain capital projects; 9) the feasibility of installing surveillance cameras; and 10) the continued review and implementation of recommendations from the Management Partners efficiency study.
