I. SUMMARY

The City Council is requested to consider co-hosting the February 29, 2012, Carson Sheriff's Station Support Foundation's (CSSSF) 6th Annual Distinguished Service Awards.

II. RECOMMENDATION

TAKE the following actions:

1. APPROVE co-hosting CSSSF's 6th Annual Distinguished Service Awards on February 29, 2012.
2. AUTHORIZE staff to assist with the preparation and coordination of the event.

IV. BACKGROUND

The CSSSF was founded in 2006 as a non-profit organization by residents and local businesses that joined forces to support the sworn deputies, the professional staff and volunteers of the Carson Sheriff's Station. Since its inception, the CSSSF has annually recognized men and women in law enforcement, public safety, highway patrol, and fire as well as community volunteers and citizens for their commitment to the safety and security of the citizens of Carson and for their heroic and unselfish acts.

CSSSF is requesting that the city join in recognizing these outstanding men and women by co-hosting the 6th Annual Distinguished Service Awards on February 29, 2011, at the Congresswoman Juanita Millender-McDonald Community Center at Carson and to authorize one staff member to assist with the preparation

and coordination of the event (ticket sales and the arrangement of the room). The City Council successfully co-hosted the previous awards held in 2010 and 2011, when the Foundation Board decided to change the venue and instead have a luncheon to enhance the program and gain exposure.
