

City of Carson Pool Rules (Subject to change)

- Masks are required for entry
- Masks must be worn properly over the nose and mouth
- Masks must be worn throughout the facility (except in the water and while showering)
- Temperature checks are taken prior to entry
- Proper Swim Attire Required (no under garments allowed – Per LA County Health):
 - Female:
 - One- or two-piece bathing suit
 - Swim shorts (optional)
 - Plain/No Logo White T-Shirt (optional)
 - Male:
 - Swim Shorts, Board Shorts, Jammers, or Speedos
 - Plain/No Logo White T-Shirt (optional)
 - Note: Those who do not have the proper swim attire will be asked to exit the pool.
- Showers are now available. Limit of 5 minutes max per use per person.
- All must social distance at least 6 feet from those who do not live in the same household
- A Waiver Form must be completed and submitted prior to entry
- Children under 7 years of age must be accompanied by an adult (18 years and above) and must remain within an arm's reach at all times
- Swim diapers are required for diaper wearing individuals
- Do not enter the water if you currently have diarrhea or had diarrhea in the last 14 days
- All must walk on deck at all times. No running is allowed.
- No glass allowed on deck.
- No food allowed on deck.
- No rough playing allowed.
- Diving in the shallow end is not allowed.
- Any persons under the influence of any kind will not be allowed in the facility
- Only participants/users entering the water will be allowed on deck. Others will need to wait outside the facility
- Parents/Guardians can drop-off their swimmers 5 minutes before the start of their Aquatic program and pick-up 5 minutes prior to the end of their program.
- We are not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
- Approved lifesaving floatation devices (both Coast Guard approved):



- Those who repeatedly exhibit unsafe behavior(s) and/or refuse to comply with any of the above-mentioned rules will be asked to exit the facility.
- The Cason Sheriff's will be contacted immediately for anyone who refuse to comply to the pool rules and/or refuse to leave the facility when asked.
