

FAQ



Q What should I bring?

We recommend bringing items such as water, sunscreen, sunglasses, and a hat to protect yourself from the sun's harmful rays and heat. If you are participating in bike riding activities, please bring your bike and a helmet.

Q Where do I check in?

The check-in table will be located adjacent to the Mobile Stage and Bike Valet area.

Q Am I allowed to bring other sports/transportation equipment besides a bike?

Only bicycles and e-bikes will be permitted in the bike riding activities.

Q Do I need a bicycle to participate? What if I do not have a bicycle?

Yes. All participants of the Bike Safety Rodeo, Explorer Ride, and Family Adventure Ride must have a bicycle. Visit our local Carson Cyclery to purchase a bike.

Q Do I have to pay for parking?

Free parking is available in Lot 3 only.

Q What happens if my bike breaks down during the bike riding activities?

Staff will be notified, and the appropriate person will be contacted to provide assistance. In addition, there will be a designated station for bike repair/assistance at the event location.

Q What if I get injured?

There will be a first aid booth on-site at the event.

Q Do all participants need to be registered to go on the bike routes?

Yes.

Q Can I register on the day of the event?

Yes. To ensure your participation, we highly recommend arriving between 7:30 am - 8:30 am. to register.

Q Will I receive anything for participating in the 9 or 20 mile bike ride?

Participants will receive a food/drink voucher, medal, riding bib, and other promotional items while supplies last. Extra food/drinks will be available for purchase.

Q Are there any age restrictions for the bicycle activities?

There are no age restrictions.

Q What if I arrive late/after the departure time for the 9 or 20 mile rides?

For safety precautions, late arrivals will not be permitted on the route.

Q What is the Bike Safety Rodeo?

A 15-minute class for younger riders or adults who are not quite ready to go on public roads. These training classes will be set up in the parking lot. Sign up on ActiveNet. Space is limited.
