



DATE OF ELECTION: Tuesday, November 8, 2022

Polls open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

- State Law: All voters will receive a mailed ballot.
- Los Angeles County determines the location, dates, and hours of all Vote Centers.

POSITIONS FOR ELECTION:

- 2 City Council Members - Districts 2 and 4 (full 4-year terms)
- City Clerk (full 4-year terms)
- City Treasurer (full 4-year terms)

CANDIDATE QUALIFICATIONS

All candidates must be 18 years of age, a Citizen of the United States, and a registered voter residing within the boundaries of their District at the time nomination papers are issued. City Clerk and City Treasurer must reside in the boundaries of the City.

NOMINATION PERIOD

Opens: Monday July 18, 2022.

Closes: Friday, August 12, 2022 – The City Clerk’s office will be open 9am to 11am on this day. Unless an incumbent does not file, then the period is extended to Wednesday, August 17, 2022.

NOMINATION PAPERS AND / OR CANDIDATE’S HANDBOOKS:

Will be available on the first day of the nomination period, Monday, July 18, 2022. “Pulling” nomination papers will take approximately 45 minutes. An appointment is requested.

City Clerk’s Office hours are: Monday – Thursday 7:00 am to 6:00 pm. On Friday, August 12th, the City Clerk’s office will be open from 9am to 11am.

COST

There is a \$25.00 filing fee and a \$250 administrative fee that is due at the time the candidate pulls papers (in the city clerk’s office), in addition to an optional candidate statement fee (due at time of submission of all forms), should the candidate desire to publish a statement in the Voter Information Guide.

CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTION LIMITS

A new State law (Stats. 2019, Ch. 556, AB 571 Mullin) provides that a state campaign contribution limit will by default apply to city and county candidates when the city or county has not already enacted a contribution limit on such candidates.

However, the City of Carson has its own resolution allowing no contribution limit for candidates (Resolution No. 20-175).

COUNCIL MEETINGS

Regular City Council meetings are held on the first and third Tuesday of each month at 5:00 p.m.

Special or Adjourned City Council meetings may be held as needed.
