### a. Truck C.U.P

Director of Community Development Saied Naaseh reported on the changes based on feedback from the Commission and business community, including but not limited to C.U.P. requirements, CEQA, existing buildings not being impacted, truck routes, and inclusion of cameras.

There is a City Council subcommittee made up of two council members. The subcommittee invited a number of community stakeholders, and they provided comments. The guidelines are based on those comments and those of the EDC. Staff will update the EDC on September 1, 2022 and present it to the Planning Commission on September 13, 2022.

### b. Façade Improvement Program

Assistant City Manager of Economic Development John Raymond reported the guidelines have been finalized for the program. The information will be available on the website, the PIO department will market the program through press releases and social media, and staff will reach out to the Chamber for assistance with spreading the word. The main commercial thoroughfares on Main Street, Avalon, Carson, and Sepulveda, will be targeted.

### c. Major Task Force Update

Commissioner Pandolfo reported that the Economic Development Strategic Plan consultants will meet with some of the major businesses to identify some pockets that already generate many visitors. In addition, the task force is still identifying new avenues to take in marketing Carson before the major events.
