

This program is federally funded. It's available to Carson renters, financially impacted by COVID-19, to assist with rent payments.

FAQ'S

Who can apply for ERA assistance? City of Carson renters.

What are the eligibility criteria? Renters must meet income qualifications and demonstrate financial impacts as a result of COVID-19. Examples include, but are not limited to, loss of employment, reduction of work hours, reduced wages.

How much financial assistance is available? *Qualified applicants may receive up to a max of \$10,000 and back payments up to 6 months.*

Do I have to repay the grant? No.

How can I apply? Click the link below to download and print the application or to request an application by mail or to pick-up an application, contact the Program Assistance hotline at (310) 233-4829.

What information is needed? Complete the ERA Application. Income documentation, rental/lease agreement and proof of COVID-19 impact are required. Please check the application and checklist for the full list of requirements and documentation. How will applications be processed? Applications are received on a first come first served basis until funds are depleted.

How do I submit my application packet? Call the Program Assistance hotline at (310) 233-4829 to schedule an appointment.

How soon will I know if I'm approved? Staff will review applications and begin providing responses within 30 calendar days, or earlier. If your application is incomplete, you will be given 5 calendar days to submit the missing information. Application will be deemed denied if missing information is not received within the 5 calendar day request for additional information.

If I'm approved, are grant funds sent directly to me? No. In accordance with HUD rules, the City will pay your landlord directly.
