INTRODUCTION AND FIRST READING OF AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARSON, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING SECTIONS 9211.3 (DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS) AND 9211.4 (SUPPLEMENTAL REGULATIONS) OF DIVISION 1 (RESIDENTIAL DISTRICTS) AND SECTIONS 9212.3 (DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS) AND 9212.4 (SUPPLEMENTAL REGULATIONS) OF DIVISION 2 (MIXED-USE DISTRICTS) OF PART 2 (BASE, OVERLAY AND SPECIAL DISTRICTS) OF THE NEW CARSON ZONING CODE (CHAPTER 1 [ZONING] OF ARTICLE IX [PLANNING AND ZONING] OF THE CARSON MUNICIPAL CODE), TO MAKE VARIOUS MODIFICATIONS TO ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH THE STATE HOUSING ELEMENT LAW, INCLUDING GOVERNMENT CODE SECTIONS 65583(c)(1) and 65583.2(h)-(i), AND CONSISTENCY WITH THE CITY'S 2021-2029 HOUSING ELEMENT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Carson, California will conduct a Public Hearing at which time you may be present and be heard to consider Introduction and First Reading of Ordinance No. 25-2510 approving Zone Text Amendment (ZTA) to the Carson Municipal Code (CMC), an ordinance amending Section 9211.3 (Development Regulations), Section 9212.3 (Development Regulations), and Section 9212.4 (Supplemental Regulations) of Part 2 (Base, Overlay And Special Districts) of the new Carson Zoning Code (Chapter 1 [Zoning] of Article IX [Planning And Zoning] of the Carson Municipal Code, as adopted by City Ordinance No. 24-2405), to make various modifications to ensure compliance with the State Housing Element Law, including Government Code Sections 65583(c)(1) and 65583.2(h)-(i), and consistency with the City's 2021-2029 Housing Element. The City Council will also consider that the adoption of this ordinance is exempt from review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under the "common sense" exemption in CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3) because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the adoption of this ordinance may have a significant effect on the environment.
