NOTICE OF WORK

Upcoming Bioventing Pilot Test Activity

Under the direction of the Regional Water Quality Control Board, Shell will be collecting soil samples, installing test wells, and conducting bioventing testing at a location on your street. Bioventing provides air to the soil to promote natural degradation of hydrocarbons in the soil. This procedure poses no health risk to residents.

During the next few weeks, you will notice additional equipment in your neighborhood. A soil vapor extraction well and associated soil vapor monitoring probes will be installed using similar methods as those used for soil sampling at residential yards in the neighborhood.

A portable soil vapor extraction unit (pictured on a back page) and generator will be parked on the street for approximately 16 days. The generator and soil vapor extraction unit will have sound proofing to reduce noise generated to levels approved by the City of Carson and Regional Water Quality Control Board. During the 2-week test, the unit will operate 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Shell will work to minimize disruption and inconvenience to the residents where the assessment will take place.

Pilot Testing	Thursday, July 26 to Sunday, August 12, 2012
Equipment Removal and Pilot Test Monitoring	Monday, August 13 to Tuesday, August 21, 2012

The above dates are planned, but may be subject to change due to weather, equipment disruptions, etc. Our goal is to complete this work as quickly as possible.
