I. Introduction

This item was originally agendized for the February 13, 2007 Planning Commission public hearing. Citing a need to resolve certain issues with the applicant and staff pertaining to a recommended condition of approval concerning a street dedication for a future right-of-way, the property owner asked that the public hearing be continued until February 27, 2007. At that meeting, the applicant requested another continuance until March 13, 2007. Although staff had met with the applicant and property owner, the issue had not yet been resolved. The applicant requested a continuance until April 10, 2007 to allow more time to consider their alternatives. To date, the applicant and owner have not yet come to a decision on how to resolve the issue at hand. Staff is recommending another continuance until May 22, 2007, which gives ample time for the concerned parties to come to terms. If a resolution has not been sought by May 22, 2007, staff will recommend that the case be continued indefinitely, or until such time that the applicant decides to move forward. Details regarding the issue will be forthcoming in a future staff report to the Commission.

CONTINUE the public hearing until May 22, 2007
