#### II. <u>Background</u>

Conditional Use Permit (CUP) No. 971-15 is for the sale and consumption of beer and wine for the movie theater at the SouthBay Pavilion Mall. The item was scheduled for a public hearing on July 28, 2015 before the Planning Commission. The applicant requested a continuance to allow them more time to discuss the direction from City Council. The Planning Commission concurred with the applicant and continued the public hearing to September 8, 2015.

#### III. Analysis

Staff has been periodically in contact with Steve Rawlings (the applicant's representative) since July 28<sup>th</sup>. Mr. Rawlings has advised staff that Century Theatres has not yet provided specific instruction to him on how to proceed with City Council's direction. Mr. Rawlings has requested the item to be continued.

#### IV. Recommendation

Staff recommends the Planning Commission continue this item to October 27, 2015. The Planning Commission is not anticipated to re-open public testimony during the September 8<sup>th</sup> meeting. However, public testimony may be provided at the continued hearing date recommended for October 27, 2015.
